Our Easter egg hunt will be Saturday, March 28, 2026. We are asking for help to collect unfilled and filled plastic Easter eggs.

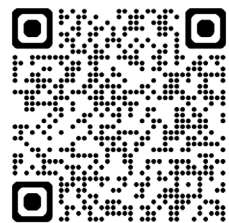
We will also be in need of candy to fill these Easter eggs. (NO CHOCOLATE PLEASE).

Women's Prayer Group

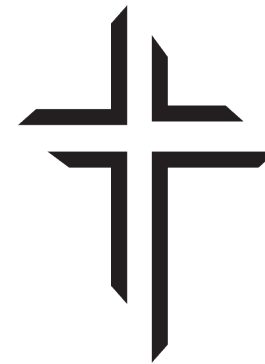
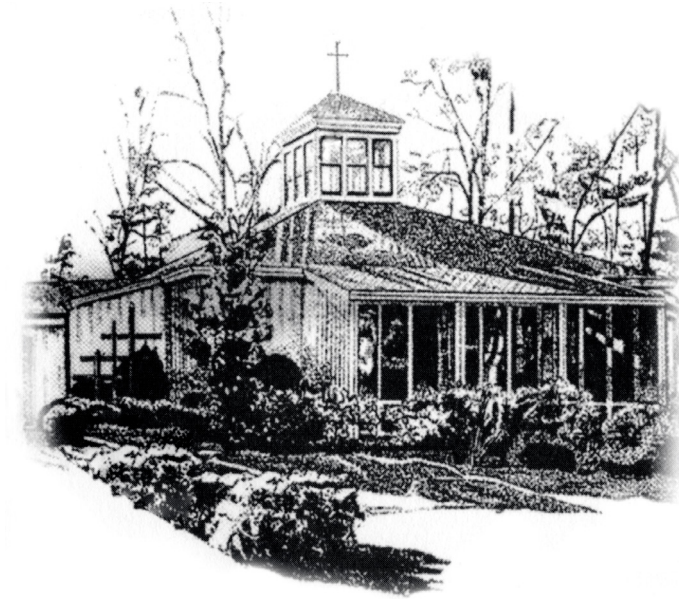
Women's Prayer Group meets on Wednesdays at 4:00 p.m. Please join us as we seek the Lord in prayer.

Concerning Christ the Mediator

1. In his eternal purpose it pleased God to choose and ordain the Lord Jesus, his only begotten Son, to be the mediator between God and man. Jesus is the prophet, priest, and king, the head and savior of his church, the heir of all things, and judge of the world. From all eternity God gave him a people to be his seed and to be in time redeemed, called, justified, sanctified, and glorified by him.

2. The Son of God, the second person of the Trinity, is truly the eternal God, of one substance and equal with the Father. In the fullness of time he took on himself the nature of man, with all the essential qualities and ordinary frailties of man—except that he was sinless. These two complete, perfect, and distinct natures, the Godhead and the manhood, were inseparably joined together in the one person of Jesus without being altered, disunited or jumbled.
